Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back to term four. I hope the holidays allowed you to spend some valuable time as a family. Term 3 was very busy and I would like to thank the staff, the Leadership Team, Mr. Marasco and Mrs. Smakman for all their hard work over the term. This term has started off well with all classrooms hitting the ground running. Term four is very busy and the children will be involved In so many exciting activities which will complement the work that is done in the classroom.

Last Monday the Prep children went to Puffing Billy and were able to experience what train travel was like a long time ago. From all accounts the children had a wonderful time and learnt so much about steam trains.

Yesterday our Grade 3/4 mixed and girl's rugby teams competed against other schools in the area. It was a fun day and both our teams were very competitive. On Friday our Grade 5/6 rugby teams will be competing against other schools in the district. The school playgroup will begin for Term 4 on Friday October 18th (8:30 - 10am) in the school library.


We welcome all families with preschool children to come along. It is a great opportunity to meet other school parents and for preschool children to become familiar in the school environment.
